AIR QUALITY ACTION DAY FOR OZONE

The ozone level for Allen County for **WEDNESDAY, JUNE 24** has been forecast to be high enough to warrant a **CAUTION**

Air Quality	Health Effects	8-Hour Ozone Average (ppb)
Good	No Health Notice - No health impacts expected when air quality is in this range.	1 to 50
Moderate	Limited Health Notice - Unusually sensitive people should consider limiting prolonged outdoor exertion.	51 to 100
Caution	Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups - Active children and adults, and people with respiratory disease, such as asthma, should limit prolonged outdoor exertion.	101 to 150
Warning	Unhealthy - Active children and adults, and people with respiratory disease, such as asthma, should avoid prolonged outdoor exertion; everyone else, especially children, should limit prolonged outdoor exertion.	151 to 200
Alert	Very Unhealthy - Everyone should limit outdoor exertion.	201 to 300
