

Lead Dust Clean-Up and Control

You Will Need:

Bucket
Clean Rags or Sponges
Liquid Soap

Warm water
Mop

Instructions:

1. **Pick up** all clothes and toys. Throw away all trash. Start where your child spends the most time.
2. **Mix** 2 tablespoons of soap in a bucket of warm water.
3. **Wipe** off windowsills, wells, moldings, and baseboard with the soap and water solution.
4. **Mop** floors, steps, in corners, and under furniture.
5. **Change** water. Wipe and mop all areas again.
6. **Flush** all the dirty water down the toilet.
7. **Wash** the rags by themselves and never use them for anything but cleaning up the lead.
8. **Wash** all toys, blankets, sheets, rugs, curtains, etc.
