

The 2015 Indiana General Assembly passed Public Law 208 that stated that all Indiana children attending an accredited school shall be immunized against meningitis. The Indiana State Department of Health has determined that to fully comply with P.L.208-2015, meningococcal serogroup B vaccine must be added to the school immunization requirements. Adding this additional vaccine series will ensure that Indiana students are protected against all strains of meningococcal disease.

For the school year 2017-18, all incoming high school seniors will be required to complete 2 immunizations to protect against all strains of meningococcal disease, the MCV4 and MEN B.
