



U.S. Residency Application Services

The Ft. Wayne-AlLEN County Department of Health provides services for the completion of the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) Medical Examination, Immunizations and Paperwork Completion for the I-693 document.

Process for Services:

- Call 260.449.7514, Option #4, for information and to schedule an appointment
- You must provide your Overseas Medical Records that include the following: *(If records are not available, a Record Search will be completed by the Department of Health, for an additional fee)*
 - 1) *Tuberculosis Worksheet*
 - 2) *Vaccination Documentation Worksheet*
 - 3) *Medical History & Physical Examination Worksheet*
 - 4) *Pre-Departure Medical Screening Form*
- You will be scheduled for 2-3 clinic visits to complete all required services that may include:
 - 1) *Laboratory tests*
 - 2) *Vaccinations*
 - 3) *Tuberculosis testing*
 - 4) *Physical Examination*
- You must bring a current government issued Photo ID to your appointments
- If interpretation is needed, **you** must provide an interpreter at the time of each clinic visit. The interpreter must be able to speak, read, and write in English.

IMPORTANT NOTE: If you come to designated appointments without an interpreter, the appointment will be rescheduled for a later date when an interpreter can accompany you to your appointment

Fees for services are due at the time of service and can vary depending on completion requirements. Please call us to discuss your needs and we look forward to working with you.
